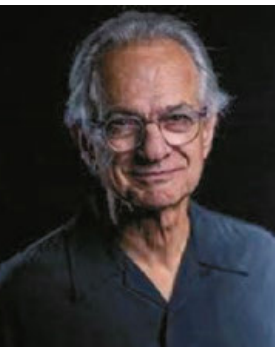

Renowned Musician Edgar Struble, a Mason County celebrity who works in a wide range of media, will share stories and music **on November 9 at 12:30.**
