We would like to thank Kerry Scrivens, Nancy Parker and Linda Cooper for their dedication and hard work in preparing for and teaching our fitness classes. These ladies volunteer their time to show us the importance of being active.

Stretch, Fit and Balance classes are our largest participating fitness classes averaging 20 participants at each class. This class is designed for all ages and exercise levels. This class features weights, bands, and small balls to maintain strength and balance while standing or sitting.

EnhanceFitness classes are also taught by these volunteers, who committed their time to become certified through an intense training program provided by Area Agency on Aging of Western Michigan. These exercises are modified so they can be done either standing or sitting. This class will help participants be more active, prevent falls and improve endurance, balance, strength, and flexibility.

#### **Thankful for a Transition Home: Taylor's Story**

Taylor suffered two strokes which resulted in his placement in a nursing facility. His guardian, Jim, was his friend first, taking on the role of legal guardian after his facility placement to help Taylor manage his affairs. "He's the best friend I've ever had," is how Taylor described this relationship.





Jim recognized that Taylor could live more independently, but had no place to go, so he began with a call to the Area Agency on Aging of Western Michigan. "Don't try to do it by yourself. Lean on others and have someone assist you with the finer points. Be sure to ask; is the place going to be a good fit? Do you have what you need to thrive?", Taylor recommends.

This is where Community Transition Services with the Area Agency on Aging of Western Michigan (AAAWM) comes in! The Transition Navigator, Taylor, and Jim worked together to come up with a plan. Taylor was able to receive assistance for housing, furniture, meals, the first month's cost of utilities, and more. Taylor also recently adopted a furry friend in his new home--a cat named Geno! Taylor is

thankful for the friends he has made along the way and is especially thankful for the transition to his new home. Jim shares, "As far as the transition, you all at (AAAWM) are angels. There were so many moving parts and complicated paperwork to fill out, it was so great to have support in making this move happen for Taylor while leaning on your agency's knowledge."

#### **About Community Transition Services:**

Community Transition Services assist those wanting to return to the community by:

- securing housing and/or arranging equipment to make the current home more accessible.
- setting up groceries and other household goods.
- coordinate referrals for in-home services through programs such as MI Choice Waiver, Care Management, and more.

Qualifications for Community Transition Services:

- reside in a facility.
- currently on, or eligible for, Medicaid.
- desire to return home or secure other housing (i.e., Apartment or assisted living).
- has a barrier to discharging safely from a facility in one of our 12 CTS counties (Allegan, Ionia, Kent, Lake, Mason, Mecosta, Montcalm, Muskegon, Newaygo, Oceana, Osceola, Ottawa).

As a Local Contract Agency, AAAWM can also meet with those residing in a facility who indicate an interest in learning about community resources. # Indoor Winter Safety Tips

So what can be done to help with the challenges that winter brings? There are some things you can do to make surviving a bad winter a little easier; here are some suggestions to help:

- Make sure your cupboard is well stocked with staples and nonperishables.
- Never use electric blankets; you may have trouble adjusting the controls in the middle of the night. This can cause burns or raise your body temperature to an unsafe level. Instead use an extra blanket.
- Dress in layers to keep warmer.
- Keep doors closed to rooms which aren't being used and close your curtains at night to conserve heat.

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# Medicare Part D Open Enrollment Period

# Open enrollment is from October 15 to December 7.

You must call to make an appointment with our MMAP counselors. We will be offering in person appointments with one of our MMAP counselors.

Call 231-845-6841.

During this annual enrollment period you can make changes to various aspects of your coverage.

- You can switch from original Medicare to Medicare Advantage, or vice versa.
- You can also switch from one Medicare Advantage plan to another or from one Medicare Part D (prescription drug) plan to another.

If you did not enroll in a Medicare Part D plan when you were first eligible, you can do so during the general open enrollment, although a late enrollment penalty may apply.

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

#### **Ask Sharon**

By the time this newsletter is published, Medicare Open Enrollment will almost be over. If you are reading this before Dec. 7, let me know if you want to check your Medicare Advantage or Drug plans. I have seen quite a few of you and have enjoyed the interactions with you.

There are a few changes to original Medicare that may affect you even if you have a Medicare Advantage plan. If you read the inside of your cover page of the "Medicare & You" book you will find them. From January 1 to March 31 you can switch Medicare Advantage plans.

Q: I heard that there is a new Medicare Advantage enrollment in January.

A: Yes, there is open enrollment for Medicare Advantage from January 1 through March 31, with your new plan

going into effect on the first of the following month after you enroll.

Q: What can you do during this time?

- A: 1. You can change from your old Medicare Advantage plan to a new plan. If you want to make sure you have the best plan for your needs, I can compare plans for you.
- 2. You can drop your Medicare Advantage plan and return to original Medicare and a drug plan.
  - 3. You cannot switch from Original Medicare to a Medicare Advantage plan.
  - 4. You also cannot change your drug plan or join a drug plan for the first time, at this time. Drug plans can only change during drug plan open enrollment in the fall.

If you are reading this column, you are holding a copy of our newsletter or reading it online. Please check our what's going on at a center near you and come in and enjoy any of the activities, or just some conversation.
