Scottville Area Senior Center to Install Automated Check-In System

An automated check-in system, called "MySeniorCenter," will soon be installed at the entrance of SASC. This is an updated version of the kiosk we used previously, and will replace our current paper sign-in sheets.

It's specifically designed to help our staff members manage the various signups and sign-ins, and improve the way we report our services to the organizations that provide our vital operating funding. These include the Mason County Board of Commissioners and Area Agency on Aging of Western Michigan, as well as grant funding organizations. Without their continued support our doors could not stay open and our programs at the center and throughout the county could not continue.



We trust that our guests and clients, who rely on us for services and activities, will recognize how important it is for us to accurately record and report the use of our facility and its programs.

By quickly and accurately detailing which services we're providing, and their importance to Mason County seniors, the system will increase our chances of receiving additional funding in the future. Today *MySeniorCenter* is being used by over 2,200 senior centers across the U.S. and Canada—so it's a proven way to keep accurate records.

How to sign in

The new system is extremely easy to use. Here's how it works:

- 1. All visitors and volunteers will receive a small keytag. (The card contains no personal information, but it will allow the new system to recognize you without entering your name each time.)
- 2. Instead of signing into our guest list, you'll swipe your keytag at the scanner. If you happen to forget your tag, you can still enter your name on the touchscreen.
- 3. Daily activities will be displayed on the screen (see below).
- 4. Tap the touchscreen to select the programs you'll be participating in that day.
- 5. Tap FINISH.



A Smooth Transition

Mellissa Kissell, one of our two new services managers (see pg.5), is leading the installation of the updated kiosk. Even though *MySeniorCenter* is designed to be user-friendly, she and other staff members and volunteers will be available to help our guests get used to operating the new check-in system. We will make the transition as seamless as possible for everyone.

Ask Sharon By Sharon Bailey, Medicare Counselor at SASC

By the time you read this Open Enrollment is almost over. There a few days left if you want to check your Medicare Advantage or Drug plans. I have seen quite a few of you and have enjoyed the interactions with you. There are a few changes to original Medicare that may affect you even if you have a Medicare Advantage plan. If you read the inside of your cover page of The Medicare & You book you will find them. From January 1 to March 31 you can switch Medicare Advantage plans. I am filled up for this year so if you still interested you open Medicare.gov the Official site .

- Q. I heard that there is a Medicare Advantage enrollment in January.
- A. Yes there is open enrollment for Medicare Advantage from January 1 through March 31, with your new plan going into effect the on the first of the following month after you enroll.
- Q. What can you do during this time?
- A. 1. You can change from your old Medicare Advantage plan to a new plan. If you want to make sure you have the best plan for your needs I can compare plans for you.
 - 2. You can drop your Medicare Advantage plan and return to original Medicare and a drug plan.
 - 3. You cannot switch from Original Medicare to a Medicare Advantage plan.
 - 4. You also cannot change your drug plan or join a drug plan for first time at this time. Drug plans can only change during drug plan open enrollment in the fall.
