We received a gift of stockings from our quilters for the third graders in Mason County Central, who visit us each year with presents of coffee, tea, and other gifts...all of which are greatly appreciated! We have been given beautiful skeins of yarn, which can be used in so many different classes or projects.

We are, of course, thankful for all the monetary gifts we receive each year.....from our "regulars" and from folks we hardly know. These gifts have let us purchase strong raised flower beds for our patio and have allowed us to offer a stipend to some of our presenters.

Medicare Open Enrollment Through Dec. 7

Enrolling in or renewing Medicare/Medicaid can be confusing and complicated. Each year, open enrollment occurs from October 15 - December 7. This provides the chance for individuals to review and make changes to their Medicare Part D prescription plans and Medicare Advantage plans. Changes can include monthly premiums, yearly deductibles, copays, prescription formulary (list of covered medications), and pharmacy network.

Making changes to your insurance can be overwhelming—how do you know which option best fits you? Here are a few tips for navigating the open enrollment season:

1. **Know the difference between Medicare and Medicaid.** "Medicare is a medical program for people over 65 and younger disabled people and dialysis patients. Medicaid is an assistance program for low-income patients' medical expenses," explains the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. If you are a senior, then it's likely you are trying to navigate Medicare. All changes to your plan must be made by December 7, and new coverage begins on January 1, 2026.

2. Seek help from a trusted source.

For Mason County residents, both the Scottville and Ludington senior centers have counselors to help with Medicare Open Enrollment. To make an appointment with Sharon Bailey at the Scottville center, call 231-757-4052 or leave a message at the center's main number: 757-4705. Also see Sharon's monthly column on page 19. For an appointment at the Ludington center, call the center at 231-845-6841.

The Michigan State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) provides unbiased help with Medicare and Medicaid at no charge. This state-wide program doesn't sell Medicare plans. Instead, certified volunteer counselors are there to walk you through your options. It's a program designed specifically to help older adults, their families, and caregivers. Bob Callery, SHIP Regional Director, explains, "SHIP counselors can help people navigate the complexities of Medicare. Our counselors are unbiased and want to help people find what best fits their needs and is the most cost-effective." You can set up an appointment with a SHIP specialist through the Area Agency on Aging of Western Michigan by calling (616) 456-5664.

- 3. **Be aware of scams**. Especially during open enrollment, scammers may pose as representatives offering assistance in signing you up for healthcare coverage. Below are a few scam scenarios:
- An unsolicited "agent" calls and offers to help enroll you in a health plan.
- You are asked for your personal information, such as Medicare or Social Security number.
- You are offered "free gifts" in exchange for your personal information.

These are all examples of scams. Legitimate agents need your permission to contact you. You are able to get information about Medicare plans from legitimate sources without providing personal information or accepting gifts. Legitimate sources will not ask for any ID number unless you are actually enrolling.





Ask Sharon By Sharon Bailey, Medicare Counselor at SASC

I have been getting a lot of calls about a Blue Cross Medicare plan no longer available after December 31. If you received one of these letters and you don't know to do, I will be glad to help you get a new plan.

I have been busy seeing people about the 2026 Medicare plans because they change from time to time. If you have any concerns I will be glad to see you until Open Enrollment closes on Dec 5. My number is 757-4052.

- Q. Are the Medicare Advantage Plans expensive?
- A. No. there are plans in all price ranges, but a lot of them are at no cost, With low or no deductibles.
- Q. What about prescription drugs?
- A. They also cover prescription drugs. With no deductible.
- Q. How do private insurers get paid?
- A. Medicare pays them from your account each month.
- Q. Do I have to use two insurance cards?
- A. No, you would only need the card from the insurance company. Just put your Medicare card away in a safe place.
- Q. Is Medicare Advantage the plan that has extra things that they cover?
- A. Yes, it covers some dental, eyeglasses and hearing aids, but not all. They also cover some over the counter drugs. If you qualify, some plans cover some healthy foods.

I hope to see some of you this fall. My favorite thing to do is help people save money.
